

# **COURSE SYLLABUS**

The remaining 5% of your grade will be determined by your engagement in our discussion boards. We (the TA and I) have come up with 4 questions/topics (one for each section of the course); you will be required to respond to one of these topics. To get your points (5 points total), you will need to GENERATE an original written comment/thought of your own (2 points) and RESPOND in writing to someone else's comment/thought (2 points). Finally, you will be required to participate in an oral discussion about the same topic (1 point). Keep in mind, that we won't grade the content of your posts, but we can easily detect differences between posts demonstrating interest and/or understanding in the topic from posts that are simply submitted to meet the requirements.
