Math Placement for Entering Students

The Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) degree at UToledo requires **MATH 1730** – *Calculus with Applications to Business and Finance*. However, not every student begins by taking that course. The first math course you are placed into is usually based on your ACT/SAT math score.

PLACEMENT IS DETERMINED AS FOLLOWS:

COURSE	ACT MATH SCORE	SAT MATH SECTION SCORE
MATH 1730 <i>Calculus with Applications to Business and Finance</i>	24 or higher	580 or higher
MATH 1320 <i>College Algebra</i>	22 – 23	550 – 570
MATH 1320 w/ Support Lab <i>College Algebra</i>	18 – 21	510 – 540
MATH 1200 <i>Mathematical Modeling and Problem Solving</i>	17 or lower	500 or lower

If you do not have an ACT/SAT score or if you want to place into a higher math class, then you can take the ALEKS math placement test.

HOW DO I TAKE THE ALEKS MATH PLACEMENT TEST?

You will need your UTAD username and password to access ALEKS. If you have not yet activated your UTAD account, visit <https://www.utoledo.edu/orientation/new/utad-account.html> for step-by-step directions.

There is a **non-refundable \$20 fee** (paid by credit card) to access the ALEKS math placement test. This fee is assessed by McGraw Hill Education once you log in with your UTAD credentials. The University of Toledo does not accept payment for ALEKS.

With the \$20 fee you will obtain access to:

- x One initial placement test
- x A 6-week subscription to the Prep and Learning modules to elevate your current math knowledge
- x Two additional "re-take" placement tests which you may take to raise your placement score
