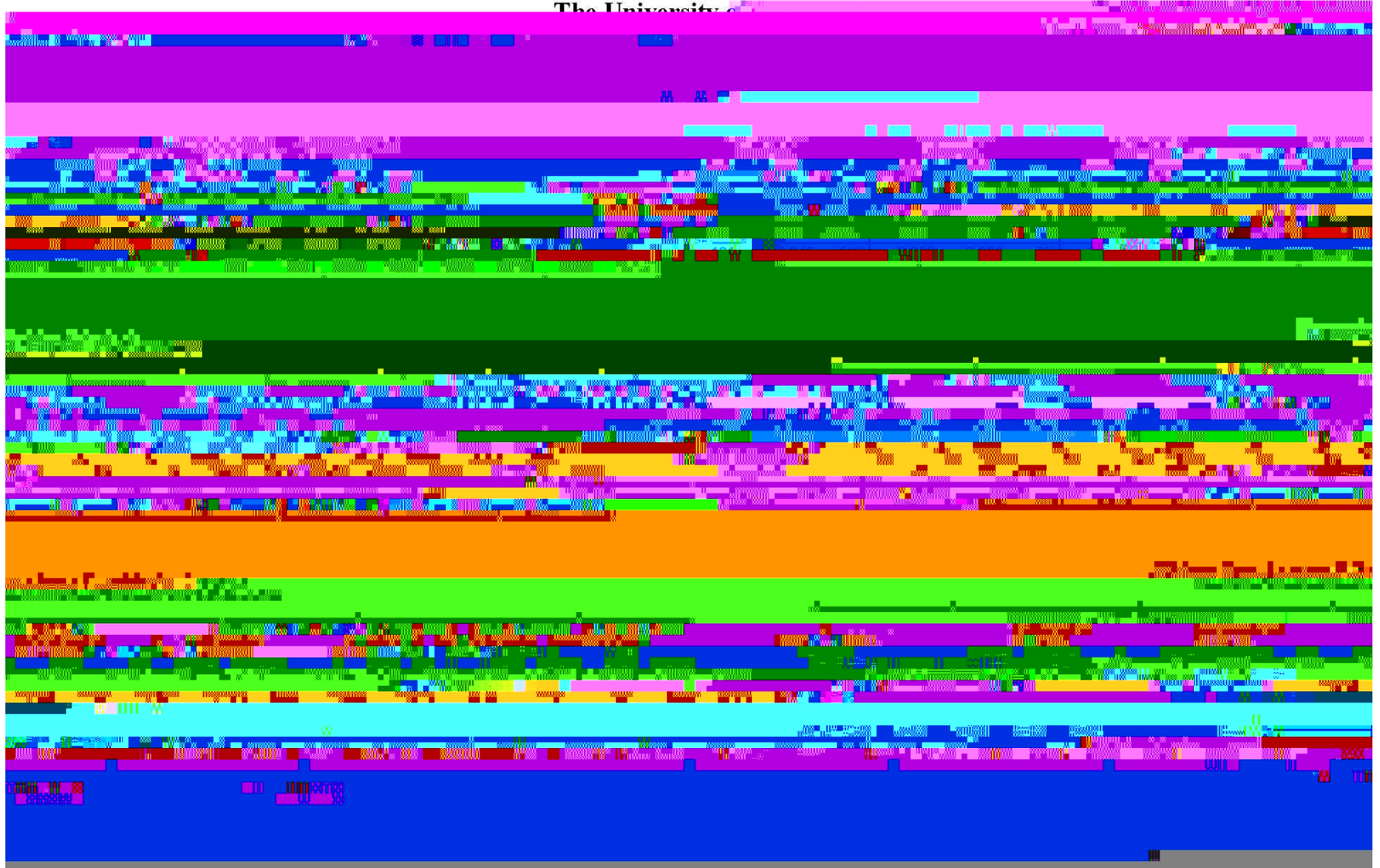

Headcount by Level, Age, and Gender

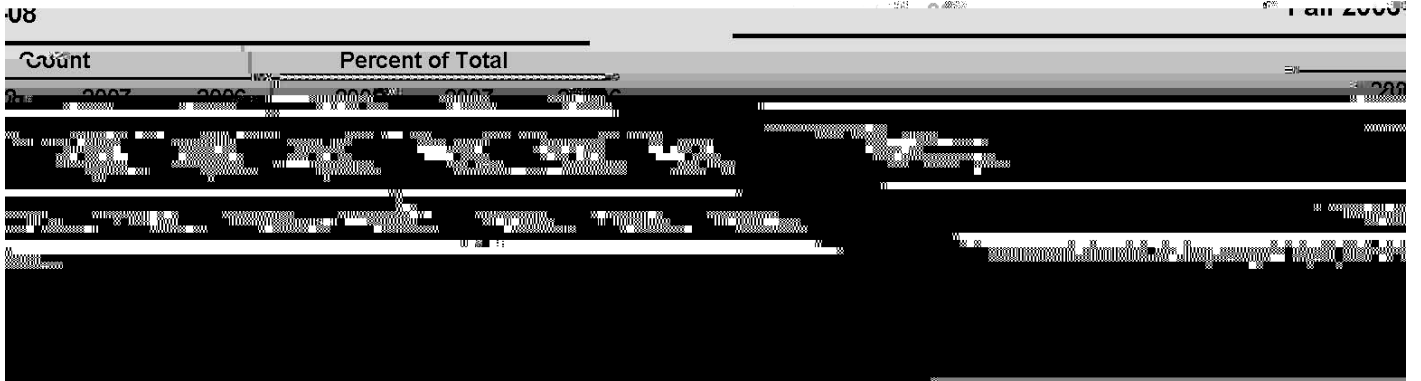

Number and Percentage of Undergraduates with Undergraduate Degrees

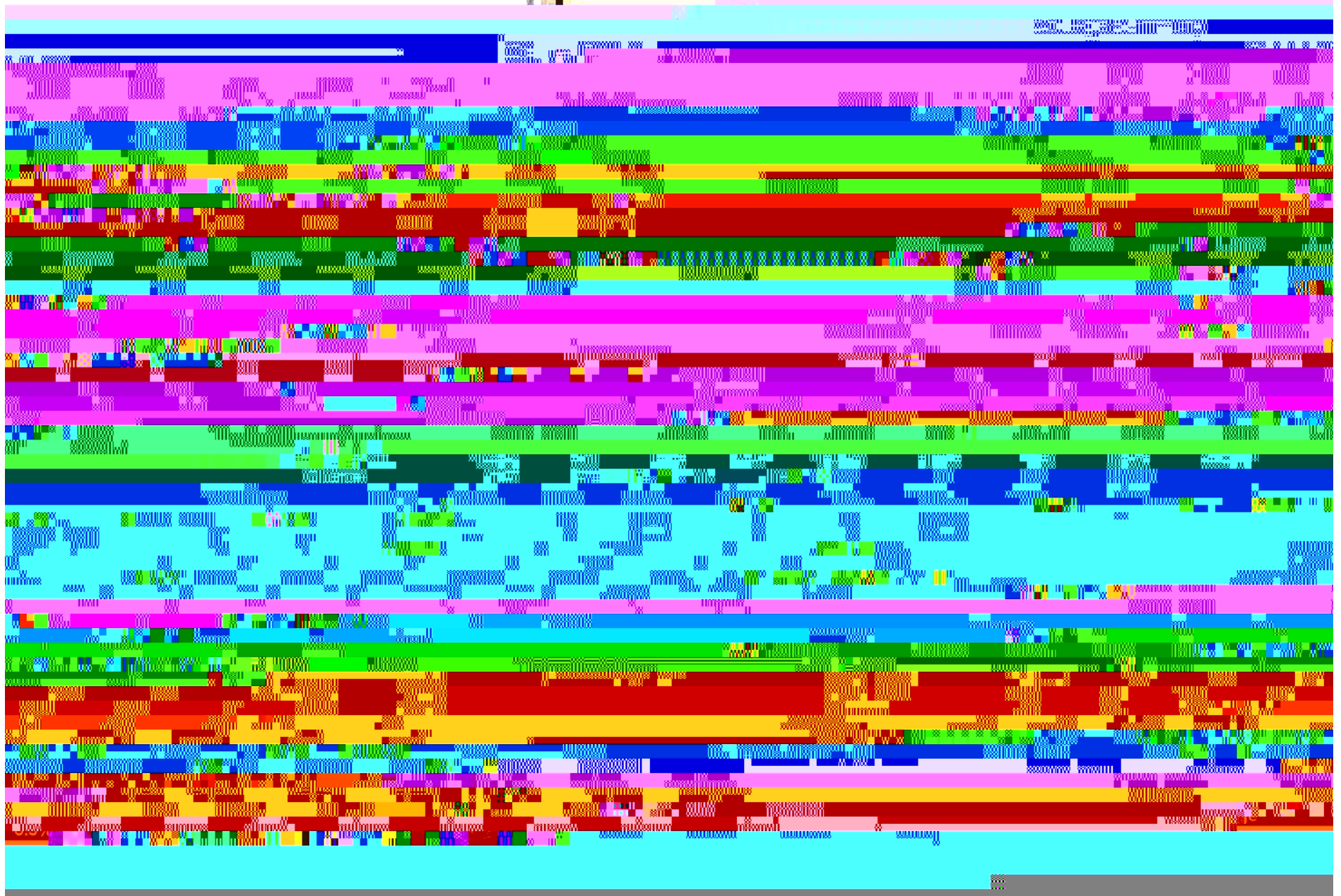

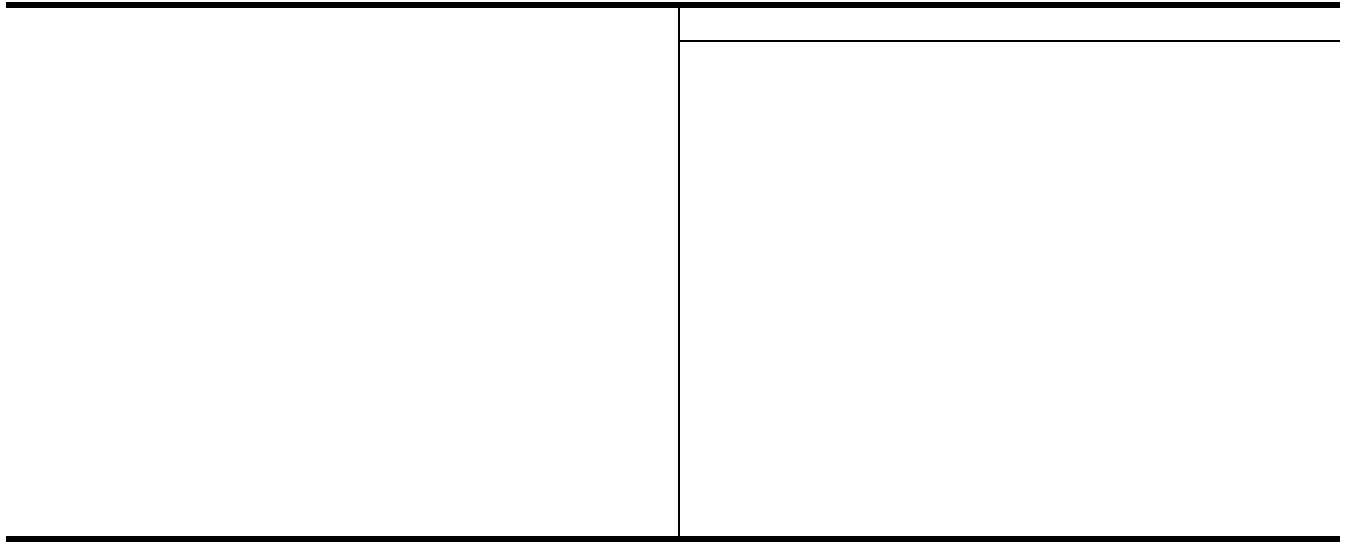
