STATEMENT OF SELECTIVE SERVICE REGISTRATION COMPLIANCE

In August 1986, the Ohio General Assembly passed House Bill 845 which requires that all male students between the ages of 18-26 and who are Ohio residents must register with the Selective Service System and file a statement of their selective service status, or must be charged the tuition surcharge for non-Ohio residents for attendance at any state college or university.

The University of Toledo and its eligible male students are required to verify selective service status; please do so by checking the appropriate statement, completing the requested information, and signing below.

I am a male, Ohio resident between the ages of eighteen and twenty-six, and have registered with the Selective Service System.

I have registered with Selective Service via the Web and am attaching confirmation.

I have recently registered with Selective Service within the past six weeks, but have not yet received my confirmation, since Selective Service processing may take 30 to 90 days. I understand that should I appear listed as non-compliant (not registered) next semester, I will be assessed the non-resident tuition surcharge for this semester, as well as all future semesters until I provide proof of registration.

I am on full-time active duty in the United States military. (This does include being in the Ohio National Guard or military reserves.)

I am a female.
